## Addendum to Wildlife Damage Management Resistance of Ornamentals to Deer Damage **Invasive Plant Alert!**

Since this publication was written, the plants listed below have been identified and labeled as invasive non-native plants. They may be still sold in area nurseries but because of the high probability for damaging the environment and wildlife habitat, **the following plants should not be planted.**

### Rarely Damaged

Shrubs and Climbers

*Berberis spp.*

Annuals, Perennials, and Bulbs

*Pachysandra terminalis*

Japanese Spurge - OK if not beside a natural area.

### Seldom Damaged

Honeysuckle shrub and/or vine - Native honeysuckle vines are OK.

*Mentha spp.*

Mint - OK if not beside a natural area.

### Occasionally Damaged
